A Definition. Narrative therapy is a form of therapy that aims to separate the individual from the problem, allowing the individual to externalize their issues rather than internalize them. It relies on the individual's own skills and sense of purpose to guide them through difficult times (Narrative Therapy, 2017).

Narrative therapy is a kind of psychotherapy in which individuals identify their skills and abilities to help them resolve their conflicts. It enables individuals to solve their problems by themselves, using their own abilities. Narrative therapy aid individuals in finding out their values and exploring skills that are associated with those values.
